

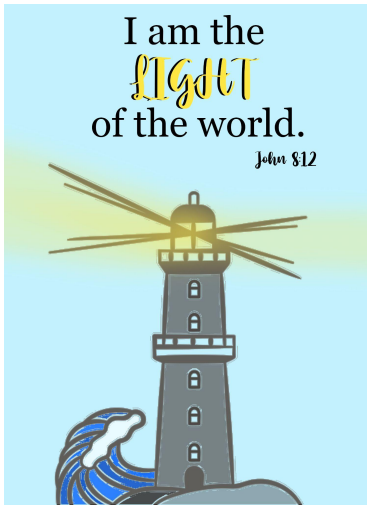

## Mr. Falk: Grades 7-8

- The New Testament lessons have been focused on the births of John the Baptist and of Jesus. It's interesting how Matthew tells the Jews in his Gospel each time an Old Testament prophecy is fulfilled.
- The students have finished their first chapter in math. They have learned about integers, properties like commutative and distributive, algebraic expressions with variables, and the coordinate plane.
- The English grammar classes have been looking at nouns: plurals, collectives, and proper. They have also studied verb phrases and helping verbs.
- The students had their first science chapter test last week. Now we begin to learn about cell processes like respiration and photosynthesis.
