The Morning Cup of...Mercy?

When you get up in the morning, you probably have some kind of a routine. One of the first things I do is to turn on our Keurig machine. While the water is heating, I pick out the coffee I would like to have that morning and get my cup out of the cabinet. When the machine is ready the K-cup goes into the machine and the button is pushed. Out of that wonderful machine is my morning cup of coffee. The aroma and the sound of the coffee brewing is just amazing. That first sip of the morning cup hits the spot. I may not necessarily need that cup, but it's just nice to enjoy that cup of coffee in the morning. Every morning it is a new cup of coffee to enjoy, but the same great taste. The cup of coffee might not be needed. It might not even be something that you like to drink, but the truth is we need God's morning cup of mercy.

On May 19th, we had Pastor Elton Stroh here from Crossroads Consulting introducing us to how he and his consulting firm could help our congregation plan for the future. That's not the reason I bring up his presentation. Even though we know, that we are at the same time both sinner and saint washed in the blood of Jesus, he asked us this thought provoking question. In the morning when you get up and look in the mirror, which one do you tend to see yourself more as - sinner or saint?" How do you answer?

When you look into the mirror and see yourself more as a sinner than as a saint, you are staring into the mirror of God's Law. It's convicting you. It's showing you all the things you had done wrong the day before or even that morning already. Looking into the Law, your day cannot be right. It cannot be a day of peace. It cannot be a day of joy filled service to God. You, like everyone else in this world, need God's cup of mercy that is new every morning so that you are not consumed by those daily failures.

The prophet Jeremiah wrote in Lamentations 3:22-23, "**Because of the Lord's great love, we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.**" Think about the reason for the prophet's lament. He looked out and saw the destruction of the temple and the city of Jerusalem. It grieved him. He had every reason to lament over the sins of God's people, for his sins, and for the loss that was all around him. Hence the name of the book. Yet even in grief and sadness, he points to God's great love and mercy and we are not consumed.

He never fails to have compassion on those who come before him and repent of their sins trusting in Jesus for complete forgiveness. Every day his mercy is new. Every day is a new day of grace that the Lord continues to show us compassion and love. Because of his great mercy in Christ Jesus, we are not consumed. Surely great is his faithfulness to us. Rejoice in that every morning, every day God gives each one of us a cup of his mercy to taste and enjoy in his compassion, love and faithfulness.

Whether you enjoy coffee or not, God's cup of mercy is one we need to rejuvenate us showing us what we also are. We are his saints. We are loved by him, washed by the blood of his Son, and his faithfulness to us never fails. It is new every morning. Reach for the cup of his Word not just on Sunday mornings but all the time. While you are enjoying that morning cup of coffee, enjoy God's morning cup of mercy which he shares with you.

Prayer:

Every morning mercies new fall as fresh as morning dew. Every morning let us pay tribute with the early day. For your mercies, Lord, are sure; your compassion will endure. Still your kindness and your love every day our sins remove; daily, far as east from west, lift the burden from the breast; give unbought to those who pray strength to live for you each day. Amen (CW 580 vs. 1-2)
